### Curriculum

Reading, math, language arts, science, social studies, history, art, music, physical education, world languages, library skills, computer skills, environmental studies, conflict mediation, and multicultural studies.

### Special Programs

World languages including French, Spanish and Mandarin Chinese; computer literacy; music and drama productions; photography; environmental science and global studies; overnight class field trips for ages 6 and above; overseas field study for graduating class. Before and after school extended care. Afterschool activities. Child care for children six weeks to three years old. Summer camp, sports teams, chess club, math team, yearbook. Two school counselors.

### Facilities

Forested areas, playgrounds, a sport field, picnic areas and an environmental science outdoor classroom are located on campus. The Evergreen School library contains over 23,000 volumes. Two computer labs, laptops for all students Grade 4 and above. The intermediate and middle school facility houses classrooms, common area, science, and computer lab. Gymnasium, performing arts center (classrooms and theatre), art studios and village green.
